Wearable technology has already started to deliver innovation:


- Improving health and fitness awareness


From awe-inspiring responsive runway dresses to scientific wearables with practical applications, Make Fashion designers are inspired by fashion with functionality.

Our 2014 gala will introduce a number of new artists and designers exploring the integration of technology with their art and design practices.


Kenzie Housego and Amie May - Drawing inspiration from retro headwear combined with technology, this artist pair will create a series of headdresses for the 2014 gala.




